Part 1: INTERMI

For the interment of the body of:	£
A stillborn child, or of a person whose age at the time of death did not exceed one month	Nil
A person whose age at the time of death exceeded one month but did not exceed twelve years	Nil
A person whose age at the time of death exceeded twelve years	360.00
The fees indicated apply where the interment is at a depth exceeding 1200mm but not exceeding 2400mm	
For the interment of cremated remains:	
In a casket or urn in the memorial garden or a partner's grave.	166.00
The above fees apply only where the interment is between the hours of 9am and 4pm on a weekday	
Part 2: EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES	
For the exclusive right of burial for 99 years in an earthen grave 7 feet (2100mm) x 3 feet (900mm)	472.00
For the exclusive right of burial for 99 years of cremated remains in an earthen grave 3 feet (900mm) by 3 feet (900mm)	260.00
Part 3: MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES AND INSCRIPTIONS	
For the right to erect or place on a grave or vault in respect of which the Exclusive Rights of Burial has been granted, a headstone, cross, vase, pillar or tablet including the first inscription and not exceeding 4 feet (1200mm) in height, 3feet (900mm) in width and 1foot (300mm) in depth	145.00
For the right to erect or place over the interment of ashes in respect of which the Exclusive Rights of Burial has been granted, a headstone, cross, vase, pillar or tablet including the first inscription and	
4 feet (1200mm) in height, 3feet (900mm) in width and 1foot (300mm) in depth	72.00
For each additional inscription	62.00
The above fees apply where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is or imme before death was an inhabitant or parishioner of Bere Regis or in the case of a stillborn child where the part	-

The above fees apply where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is or immediately before death was an inhabitant or parishioner of Bere Regis or in the case of a stillborn child where the parents (or one of them) are or is at the time of interment such inhabitants or parishioners. In all other cases the fees will be doubled except those in Part 1 & 3 where the exclusive right of burial was obtained at a single fee. The Council has the discretion to charge a single fee for those who have left the parish but who, in the opinion of the Council, have been of great service to the parish.
