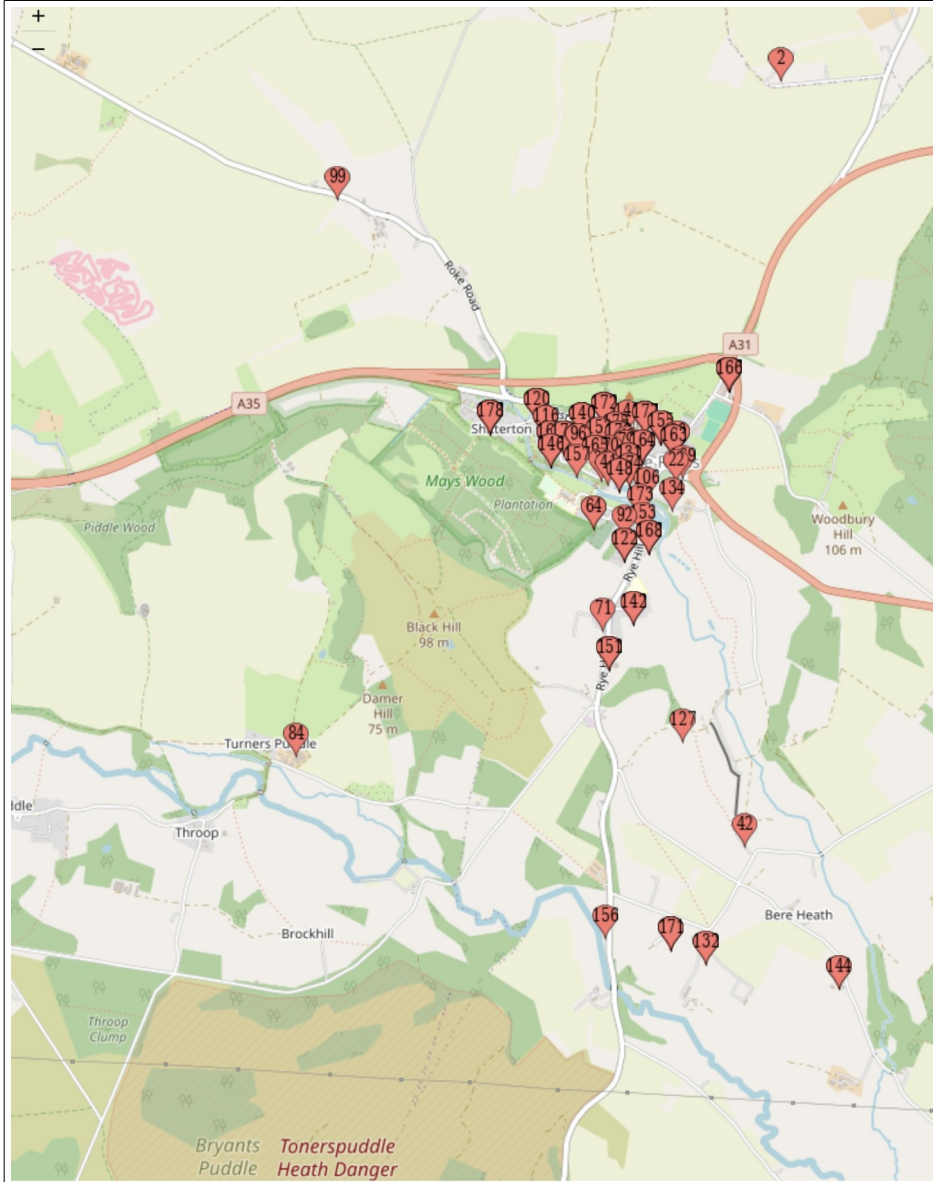




Outcome of the Bere Regis Parish Council Community Survey – April 2024



Map 1 – Postcode Distribution for Bere Regis Parish as a whole

Survey Results by Numbers

Number of Surveys distributed to households - ~750

Total responses received – 179

Electronic responses - 110

Paper responses – 69

The maps show the approximate geographical distribution of responses by post code: Map 1 shows responses across the parish as a whole (approximately); Map 2 shows the responses from village centre. Note that each marker represents an individual post code, but there may have been a number of submissions from within that post code.

The maps show an even distribution of respondents, both in the village centre and the wider parish.

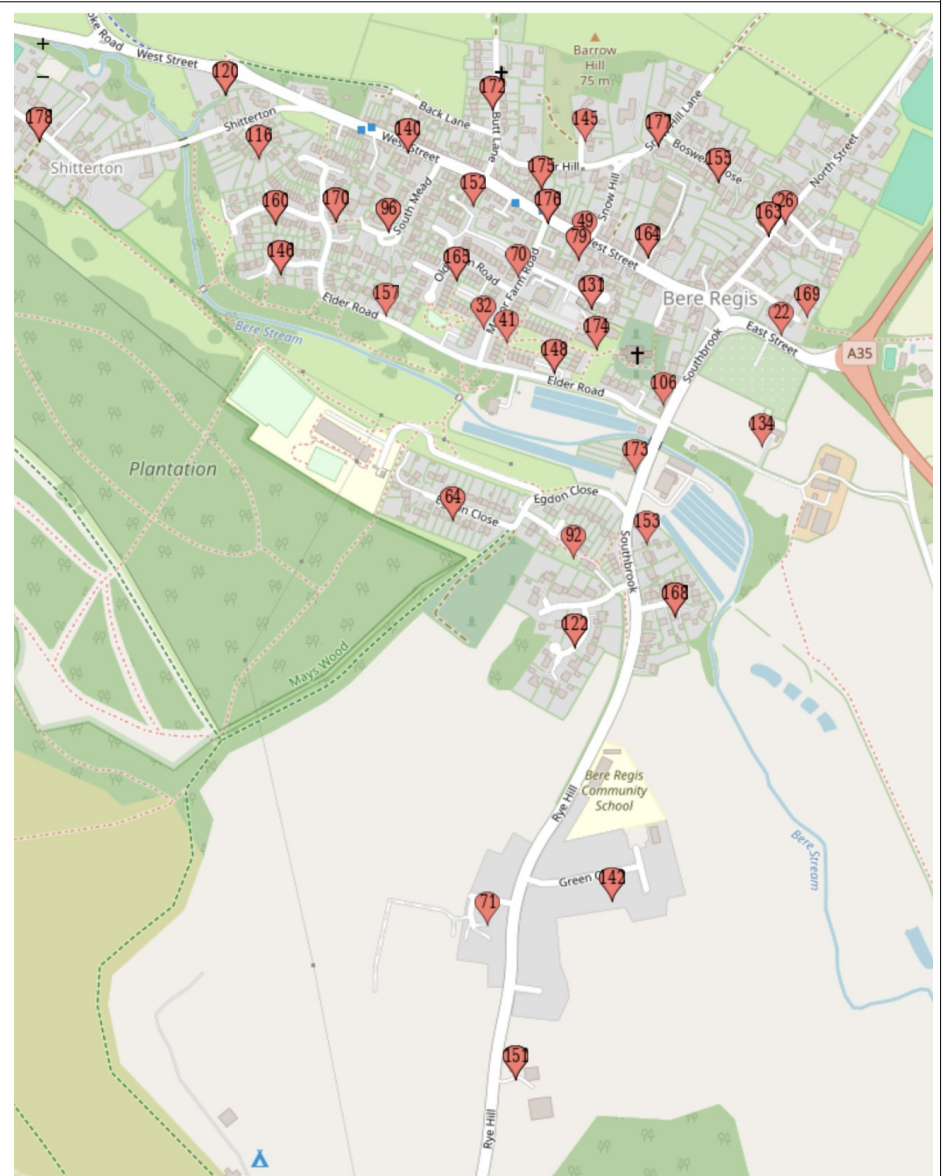
In April 2024, the Parish Council undertook a community survey, to look at two key areas of interest:

- communication
- traffic

Communication: we wanted to review the way that we engage with the community and, ideally, to improve it. We asked a number of questions about the way you like to receive information from the Parish Council and the type of information you would like to receive.

Traffic: we are well aware of a range of traffic-related issues in our village. We asked a number of questions about traffic issues (speeding, traffic volumes, parking, etc) which we know cause a variety of concerns in various locations.

The survey was made available both electronically, and also on paper delivered to all households in the parish.
