

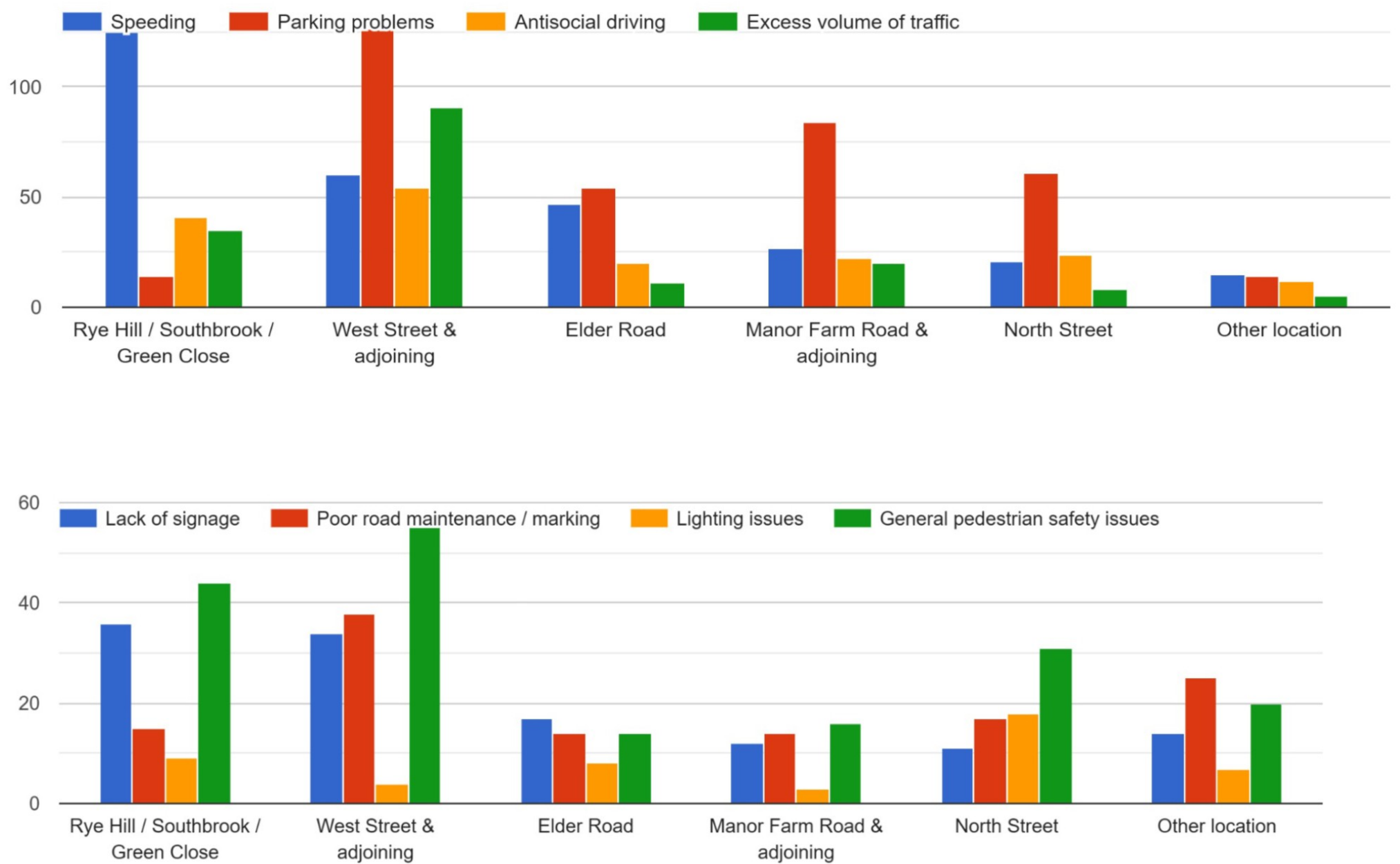


Outcome of the Bere Regis Parish Council Community Survey – April 2024

Traffic and Road-related Results 1

WHAT ARE THE ISSUES – we already had a good idea of the traffic, and other road-related safety issues in the village. The community survey was designed to confirm these, but we also wanted to give you the opportunity to identify any other traffic problems.

Our focus was on speeding, parking, antisocial driving, excess traffic, signage, road maintenance, lighting and general pedestrian safety. Based on past incidents, local knowledge and input from parishioners, we chose the locations displayed on the charts below as our focus. The taller columns in the charts below give a clear idea of where survey respondents feel the main issues lie.



It will come as no surprise to many parish residents that the dominant issues are:

- speeding on Rye Hill/ Southbrook, but also West Street & Elder Road and, to a lesser extent, North Street;
- parking problems across the village centre, discussed on the next display board;
- general pedestrian safety, almost certainly in part, as a result of the above 2 issues.

YOUR COMMENTS – 50 of you took the opportunity to add specific comments to your survey responses, many of these contained significant detail which we are summarised on the next display board.
