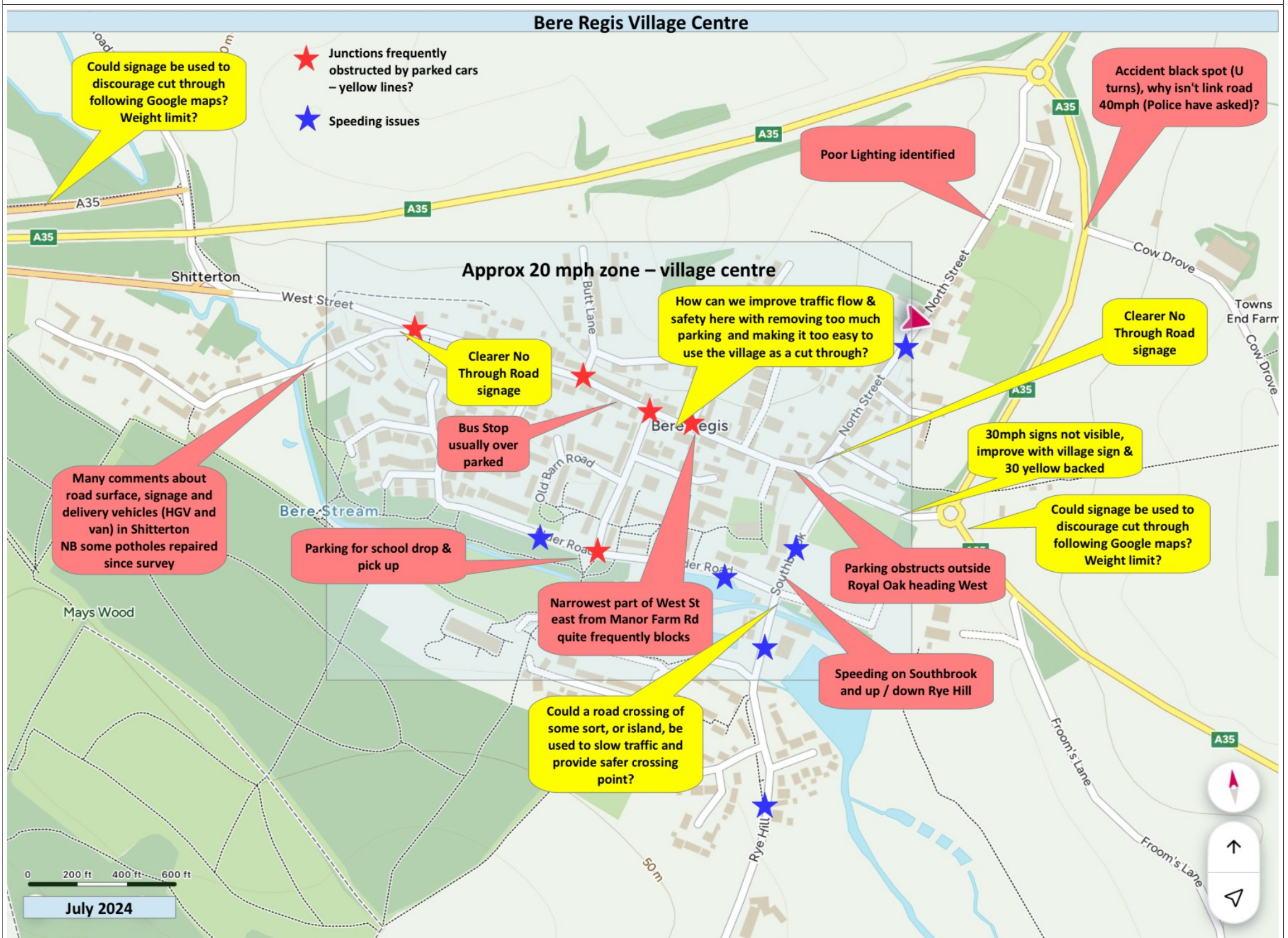




Outcome of the Bere Regis Parish Council Community Survey – April 2024

Traffic and Road-related Results 4

NEXT STEPS – the annotated map below has been prepared for discussion with Dorset Council Highways Department. The will take place in the next few weeks, and a site visit has been arranged. This is not an exhaustive list of issues but it gives a good illustration of the problems raised, and some potential suggestions (in yellow boxes).



OTHER ISSUES – whilst Village Centre issues dominate the concerns raised in the survey, a number of other issues that have been raised will also be discussed with Dorset Council.

Exiting from Green Close – visibility very poor, significantly exacerbated by speeding traffic on Rye Hill

Pedestrian Crossing on Rye Hill – multiple reports of vehicles not stopping & thus near misses

Roke Road – speed of traffic, collisions near the bridge, could speed limit be introduced?

Snatford Bridge – damaged on a number of occasions, could signage be improved?

Road Surface Issues – in various outlying locations including Lane End
