

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER VARIOUS ROADS, EAST STOKE & ARNE

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 5th May 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months, however, it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 10th June 2025 and 25th June 2025.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway surface dressing works.

The effect of the order is as follows:

[1] To impose temporary road closure on Puddletown Road, East Stoke & Arne from the junction with Tout Hill to the junction with A352 Worgret Hill (in both directions), a distance of approximately 6940 metres. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections. Please note the closures will be in operation, as and when indicated by signs on site. Advanced warning signs will be placed on the road two weeks advance of the closure to indicate the exact dates the closure will affect the roads.

[2] To impose a temporary speed restriction of 10mph to facilitate the use of a convoy working vehicle along B3070, East Stoke from a point 200 metres to the north of the junction with East Holme to the junction with Holme Lane as listed and indicated by signs on site.

[3] To impose clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Various Roads, East Stoke & Arne as listed: [i] Puddletown Road, East Stoke & Arne from the junction with Tout Hill to the junction with A352 Worgret Hill (in both directions), a distance of approximately 6940 metres; [ii] B3070, East Stoke from a point 200 metres to the north of the junction with East Holme to the junction with Holme Lane. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
